



Our Saviour Church Dedicates Parsonage

With the words "Blest and dedicated be this house," the \$24,000 parsonage of Our Saviour Lutheran Church will be dedicated at a special service on Sunday by the pastor, the Rev. Frederick G. Gotwald.

Designed by Douglas Diver and constructed by Joseph Moje, this new home for the pastor is the first half of the church's Sunday School—Parsonage Expansion project.

Work on the second half of the project, which will provide seven fully equipped classrooms, a Church parlor and office is now being done by volunteer members of the congregation. Completion of this conversion of the old living quarters of the pastor into Sunday School facilities is anticipated in the next few months.

An Open House for 300 invited guests will be held at the new parsonage on Sunday afternoon from 2 to 6 with the Church Councilmen and their wives as hosts for the occasion. Arrangements for the affair are being made by Mrs. Frederick G. Gotwald, with the help of members of the congregation.

The Sunday School-Parsonage expansion was made possible when a campaign for \$24,000 resulted in pledges of \$26,000 under the general chairmanship of Ernest R. Frutiger last fall. Building of the parsonage was supervised by Mr. Frutiger, Charles F. Schlechting and George B. Wilson. Construction of the new Sunday School facilities is under the leadership of Mrs. Alvin T. Rogers.



Our Saviour Lutheran Church will observe the 13th anniversary of the dedication of its parish hall by re-dedicating it on Sunday, October 25. The building will be named the "Frederick G. Gotwald Fellowship Hall" in honor of the man who served as the congregation's pastor for more than 20 years. Pastor Gotwald will preach at the 10:30 worship service. The re-dedication and naming of the fellowship hall immediately follows the service. There will be an

open house after the ceremony.

Frederick Gotwald came to Our Saviour Lutheran church in 1949. During his pastorate, the congregation experienced tremendous growth. By the 1960s, the Sunday School had over 200 students, and space was also needed to run its teen program. The hexagon-shaped structure, first known as the Youth Education Building, was dedicated in February 1963.

The multi-purpose fellowship hall has always been a resource for the community as well as the congregation. At the dedication, a key to the lower level was given to the Recreation Commission of Croton for its use. Today the hall is used by community groups as diverse as the Girl Scouts, AARP, and Alcoholics Anonymous.

Pastor Gotwald was very active in the Croton community. The circle of plantings at the intersection of Benedict Boulevard and Cleveland Drive was named "Gotwald Circle" after him, and for many years the church used Gotwald Circle as its address. Pastor Gotwald left Our Saviour and Croton in 1970 to take a Lutheran synodical position in Syracuse, N. Y. He is now retired and lives with his wife, Lee, in Salisbury, N.C.

Many former members from the 1950s and '60s have been invited to the ceremony and open house. The community is also welcome.

Our Saviour Lutheran Church is located at the intersection of Benedict Boulevard and Cleveland Drive. For further information call 271-4632.


